

Lean TMS Supply Chain Monitor Course

Course Synopsis

The LeanTMS Supply Chain Monitor (SCM) course provides an in-depth learning opportunity in the setup and use of SCM within LeanTMS. Students will receive instruction in both administrative set up of the mandatory and optional components of SCM. They will be introduced to the concept of SCM and will learn how this tool can be used to improve supply chain efficiencies by setting up milestones and checkpoints during the order to cash process. Students will be shown how LeanTMS can proactively communicate possible supply chain failures. Specific topics in the 1/2 day course are listed below. This is a live instructor-led, web-based training.

Who Should Attend?

This course is designed for those users who are assigned the role of setting up, maintaining and monitoring SCM in LeanTMS. System administrators in LeanTMS would also benefit from this course to learn the setup variations for the components of SCM and to help in modifying them to meet the shipper's business requirements. Shipper planners would also benefit from this course by developing an understanding of the SCM notifications of pending failures which can be communicated via network advisors, the SCM console, and the load report timeline.

Prerequisites

We strongly recommend that students attend the LeanTMS Fundamentals foundation course prior to taking this course, or have at least one year of broad user experience within the LeanTMS application.

Learning Objectives

After attending this class, students should be able to:

- Understand how SCM can be used to improve shipper and carrier supply chain performance.
- Explain the benefits of using SCM.
- Set up network advisors to support SCM.
- Set up both easy and customized load milestone profiles.
- Configure the SCM console to meet individual users needs.
- Interpret the information provided in the timeline section of the shipper load report.
